1. Community Garden – next steps Jan 22nd is soil testing. Amy reported that results show most of the tests showed "Below Detection Limits "LOD"; only one spot an appreciable measure of lead but was still well below the DEP limits. Overall - tests showed good results with little action needed; if desired we could mitigate via amendment with compost or additional soil. Given the plans to build straw bale or raised beds gardens the soil will not be a factor. Amy reported she is finalizing the application for a grant to AtlantiCare for \$500 which she will send out for comment– expect to submit the application soon. Amy asked for a lead from the GC to get the ball rolling. Barbara suggested asking Steve Gietka to get involved on a consulting basis. Nancy described the requirements that Sustainable Jersey sets out for its applicants to be awarded points under the program. Amy noted that we have done some informal canvassing of community interest. Sara suggested we also create a Facebook post to get broader awareness and interest. Amy will seek out a list of Hammonton Apartments as the residents may desire to have a garden. Nancy suggested that we enlist the Green Earth Club to help with construction - target April.
